About this notice

The Shire of Cue collects personal information from people applying for or participating in advisory and working groups.

Why we collect your information

The information is used to:

- assess expressions of interest and appoint members
- administer meetings and group activities
- communicate with members about group matters

How your information may be used or disclosed

Information may be shared with Council members, Shire employees, public minutes, other group members or service providers where needed for the group to operate, or where authorised or required by law.

Is the information required by law?

No specific law requires you to provide this information. Providing it is voluntary.

What happens if information is not provided?

The Shire may be unable to assess your application, include you in activities or communicate with you about group matters.

Accessing or correcting your information

You may contact the Shire's Privacy Officer to enquire about personal information held about you. Formal applications to access documents, or to amend personal information that is inaccurate, incomplete, out of date or misleading, may be made under the Freedom of Information Act 1992.
