

ANIMALS COLLECTION NOTICE

About this notice

The Shire of Cue collects personal information when providing ranger services relating to dogs, cats, livestock and other animals.

Why we collect your information

The information is used to:

- register and identify animals and owners
- manage applications, complaints and enquiries
- impound animals and undertake compliance action

How your information may be used or disclosed

Information may be provided to government agencies, other local governments, microchip registries, veterinarians, animal welfare organisations or where authorised or required by law.

Is the information required by law?

Information needed for dog or cat registration and certain animal applications is required under the Dog Act 1976, Dog Regulations 2013, Cat Act 2011, Cat Regulations 2012 and Shire of Cue Dogs Local Law 2001. Information provided in complaints or enquiries is generally voluntary.

What happens if information is not provided?

The Shire may be unable to register or identify an animal, investigate a matter, return an impounded animal or take appropriate action.

Accessing or correcting your information

You may contact the Shire's Privacy Officer to enquire about personal information held about you. Formal applications to access documents, or to amend personal information that is inaccurate, incomplete, out of date or misleading, may be made under the Freedom of Information Act 1992.
