

BUILDING SERVICES COLLECTION NOTICE

About this notice

The Shire of Cue collects personal information when providing building approval, inspection and compliance services.

Why we collect your information

The information is used to:

- process permits, certificates and applications
- manage plans, inspections and pool barrier matters
- respond to enquiries and investigate compliance

How your information may be used or disclosed

Information may be provided to building regulators, emergency services, professional advisers, courts, tribunals or law-enforcement agencies where relevant or authorised by law.

Is the information required by law?

Information required for building, demolition, occupancy and approval applications is required under the Building Act 2011 and Building Regulations 2012. Information provided for general enquiries is voluntary.

What happens if information is not provided?

The Shire may be unable to process an application, complete an inspection, respond to an enquiry or undertake compliance action.

Accessing or correcting your information

You may contact the Shire's Privacy Officer to enquire about personal information held about you. Formal applications to access documents, or to amend personal information that is inaccurate, incomplete, out of date or misleading, may be made under the Freedom of Information Act 1992.
