

CCTV COLLECTION NOTICE

About this notice

The Shire of Cue operates CCTV at selected facilities and public areas to support safety, security and asset protection.

Why we collect your information

The information is used to:

- discourage crime, vandalism and unsafe behaviour
- investigate incidents, damage and complaints
- support emergency and lawful enforcement activities

How your information may be used or disclosed

Footage may be provided to WA Police, emergency services, insurers, investigators, courts or other parties where authorised or required by law.

Is the information required by law?

No specific law requires you to provide this information. CCTV images are collected automatically when you enter a monitored area.

What happens if information is not provided?

Images are captured automatically within monitored areas. It is generally not possible to opt out while remaining within a camera's field of view.

Accessing or correcting your information

You may contact the Shire's Privacy Officer to enquire about personal information held about you. Formal applications to access documents, or to amend personal information that is inaccurate, incomplete, out of date or misleading, may be made under the Freedom of Information Act 1992.
