About this notice

The Shire of Cue collects personal information when conducting surveys, submissions, workshops and other consultation activities.

Why we collect your information

The information is used to:

- gather community views and feedback
- inform planning, policy and Council decisions
- understand community needs and satisfaction

How your information may be used or disclosed

Results are generally reported in a summarised or de-identified form. Formal submissions may be published where participants are advised or publication is authorised or required by law.

Is the information required by law?

No specific law generally requires you to provide personal information for community consultation. If a statutory consultation requires identifying details, the relevant form will state the applicable law.

What happens if information is not provided?

The Shire may be unable to verify your eligibility, clarify your feedback or treat it as a valid formal submission.

Accessing or correcting your information

You may contact the Shire's Privacy Officer to enquire about personal information held about you. Formal applications to access documents, or to amend personal information that is inaccurate, incomplete, out of date or misleading, may be made under the Freedom of Information Act 1992.
