

FIREBREAKS AND FIRE HAZARDS COLLECTION NOTICE

About this notice

The Shire of Cue collects personal information when administering firebreak requirements, inspections and fire-hazard matters.

Why we collect your information

The information is used to:

- manage firebreak notices and variation requests
- conduct inspections and record compliance
- investigate hazards, complaints and offences

How your information may be used or disclosed

Information may be provided to DFES, WA Police, Fire Control Officers, volunteer brigades, contractors, other authorities or where authorised or required by law.

Is the information required by law?

Certain information for permits, applications, inspections and enforcement is required under the Bush Fires Act 1954 and Bush Fires Regulations 1954. Information provided in a general report or enquiry is usually voluntary.

What happens if information is not provided?

The Shire may be unable to assess a request, complete an inspection, investigate a hazard or take compliance action.

Accessing or correcting your information

You may contact the Shire's Privacy Officer to enquire about personal information held about you. Formal applications to access documents, or to amend personal information that is inaccurate, incomplete, out of date or misleading, may be made under the Freedom of Information Act 1992.
