

ILLEGAL CAMPING COLLECTION NOTICE

About this notice

The Shire of Cue collects personal information when responding to reports and compliance matters involving unlawful or unauthorised camping.

Why we collect your information

The information is used to:

- investigate reports and identify relevant persons or vehicles
- manage complaints and public land
- undertake compliance or enforcement action

How your information may be used or disclosed

Information may be provided to WA Police, government agencies, other local governments, land managers, property owners, contractors or where authorised or required by law.

Is the information required by law?

No specific law generally requires you to provide personal information when reporting illegal camping. Any formal enforcement notice will identify the information required by law.

What happens if information is not provided?

The Shire may be unable to investigate the report, contact relevant people or monitor and enforce compliance.

Accessing or correcting your information

You may contact the Shire's Privacy Officer to enquire about personal information held about you. Formal applications to access documents, or to amend personal information that is inaccurate, incomplete, out of date or misleading, may be made under the Freedom of Information Act 1992.
