

LITTER COLLECTION NOTICE

About this notice

The Shire of Cue collects personal information when responding to littering reports and undertaking litter enforcement.

Why we collect your information

The information is used to:

- receive and investigate complaints or reports
- identify witnesses, alleged offenders and locations
- arrange clean-up and undertake enforcement

How your information may be used or disclosed

Information may be provided to government agencies, WA Police, other local governments, property owners, contractors or where authorised or required by law.

Is the information required by law?

No specific law generally requires you to provide personal information when reporting littering. Any formal enforcement notice will identify the information required under the Litter Act 1979.

What happens if information is not provided?

The Shire may be unable to investigate the report, contact witnesses or take appropriate compliance action.

Accessing or correcting your information

You may contact the Shire's Privacy Officer to enquire about personal information held about you. Formal applications to access documents, or to amend personal information that is inaccurate, incomplete, out of date or misleading, may be made under the Freedom of Information Act 1992.
