About this notice

The Shire of Cue collects personal information when administering planning applications, referrals, submissions, enquiries and compliance matters.

Why we collect your information

The information is used to:

- assess and determine planning applications
- manage advertising, referrals and submissions
- respond to enquiries and investigate compliance

How your information may be used or disclosed

Application information may be provided to referral agencies, utilities, Council and the public where advertising or publication is required or authorised by law.

Is the information required by law?

Applicant, owner and property details required for planning applications and submissions are collected under the Planning and Development Act 2005, Planning and Development (Local Planning Schemes) Regulations 2015 and Shire of Cue Local Planning Scheme No. 2.

What happens if information is not provided?

The Shire may be unable to process an application, respond to your enquiry or undertake compliance action.

Accessing or correcting your information

You may contact the Shire's Privacy Officer to enquire about personal information held about you. Formal applications to access documents, or to amend personal information that is inaccurate, incomplete, out of date or misleading, may be made under the Freedom of Information Act 1992.
