

PRIVACY COMPLAINTS COLLECTION NOTICE

About this notice

The Shire of Cue collects personal information when receiving, assessing and responding to privacy complaints.

Why we collect your information

The information is used to:

- assess the alleged privacy interference
- investigate the circumstances and evidence
- resolve the complaint and communicate the outcome

How your information may be used or disclosed

Information may be provided to relevant Shire officers, affected persons, legal advisers or the Office of the Information Commissioner where necessary or required by law.

Is the information required by law?

Information needed to make and investigate a privacy complaint is required under the Privacy and Responsible Information Sharing Act 2024 and applicable privacy regulations.

What happens if information is not provided?

The Shire may be unable to properly assess or investigate the complaint, contact you or resolve the matter.

Accessing or correcting your information

You may contact the Shire's Privacy Officer to enquire about personal information held about you. Formal applications to access documents, or to amend personal information that is inaccurate, incomplete, out of date or misleading, may be made under the Freedom of Information Act 1992.
