

RATES COLLECTION NOTICE

About this notice

The Shire of Cue collects personal information to administer rates, property records, payments, concessions and related services.

Why we collect your information

The information is used to:

- maintain ratepayer and property records
- process payments, refunds and arrangements
- administer concessions and account changes

How your information may be used or disclosed

Information may be provided to Landgate, the Valuer-General, State Revenue, financial institutions, debt-recovery providers or other agencies where authorised or required by law.

Is the information required by law?

Owner, property and concession details needed to administer rates and rebates are required under the Local Government Act 1995, Rates and Charges (Rebates and Deferments) Act 1992 and associated regulations.

What happens if information is not provided?

The Shire may be unable to update your account, process an application or payment arrangement, apply a concession or respond to your enquiry.

Accessing or correcting your information

You may contact the Shire's Privacy Officer to enquire about personal information held about you. Formal applications to access documents, or to amend personal information that is inaccurate, incomplete, out of date or misleading, may be made under the Freedom of Information Act 1992.
