

SAFETY AND EMERGENCY SERVICES COLLECTION NOTICE

About this notice

The Shire of Cue collects personal information to support bush fire management, emergency planning, incident response and recovery.

Why we collect your information

The information is used to:

- manage volunteer, training and permit records
- record incidents, damage and response actions
- support emergency planning, welfare and recovery

How your information may be used or disclosed

Information may be provided to DFES, WA Police, emergency agencies, Fire Control Officers, volunteer brigades, health or welfare services, or where required by law.

Is the information required by law?

Certain information for bush fire permits and fire-control functions is required under the Bush Fires Act 1954 and Bush Fires Regulations 1954. Information provided for emergency planning, welfare or general enquiries is usually voluntary.

What happens if information is not provided?

The Shire may be unable to process an application or permit, maintain accurate records or effectively respond to an incident.

Accessing or correcting your information

You may contact the Shire's Privacy Officer to enquire about personal information held about you. Formal applications to access documents, or to amend personal information that is inaccurate, incomplete, out of date or misleading, may be made under the Freedom of Information Act 1992.
