About this notice

The Shire of Cue collects personal information when people interact with its social media pages and accounts.

Why we collect your information

The information is used to:

- respond to comments, messages and enquiries
- moderate content and manage engagement
- consider feedback and promote community activities

How your information may be used or disclosed

Information is handled by the relevant social media platform and may be publicly visible. It may also be provided where authorised or required by law.

Is the information required by law?

No specific law requires you to provide this information. Your interaction with the social media platform is voluntary.

What happens if information is not provided?

The Shire may be unable to respond to your message, consider your feedback or include you in the relevant engagement.

Accessing or correcting your information

You may contact the Shire's Privacy Officer to enquire about personal information held about you. Formal applications to access documents, or to amend personal information that is inaccurate, incomplete, out of date or misleading, may be made under the Freedom of Information Act 1992.
