

VEHICLES COLLECTION NOTICE

About this notice

The Shire of Cue collects personal information when responding to abandoned vehicles, parking matters, off-road vehicles and related complaints.

Why we collect your information

The information is used to:

- identify vehicles, owners, drivers and witnesses
- investigate reports and arrange operational action
- undertake compliance and enforcement

How your information may be used or disclosed

Information may be provided to WA Police, the Department of Transport, Main Roads WA, other local governments, towing contractors or where authorised or required by law.

Is the information required by law?

No specific law generally requires you to provide personal information when making a report. Any formal enforcement notice will identify information required under the applicable transport, local government or off-road vehicle legislation.

What happens if information is not provided?

The Shire may be unable to investigate the report, identify the vehicle or take appropriate operational or enforcement action.

Accessing or correcting your information

You may contact the Shire's Privacy Officer to enquire about personal information held about you. Formal applications to access documents, or to amend personal information that is inaccurate, incomplete, out of date or misleading, may be made under the Freedom of Information Act 1992.
