

WASTE SERVICES COLLECTION NOTICE

About this notice

The Shire of Cue collects personal information when providing waste collection, refuse-site and related customer services.

Why we collect your information

The information is used to:

- maintain property and service records
- process bin, collection and disposal-site requests
- respond to enquiries and reported issues

How your information may be used or disclosed

Information may be provided to waste contractors, property owners, authorised representatives, government agencies or where authorised or required by law.

Is the information required by law?

No specific law generally requires you to provide personal information for a waste service request. Providing it is voluntary, but service and property details may be needed to action the request.

What happens if information is not provided?

The Shire may be unable to verify eligibility, provide the requested service, action your request or contact you with an outcome.

Accessing or correcting your information

You may contact the Shire's Privacy Officer to enquire about personal information held about you. Formal applications to access documents, or to amend personal information that is inaccurate, incomplete, out of date or misleading, may be made under the Freedom of Information Act 1992.
