

SCHOOL HOLIDAY AND YOUTH ACTIVITIES COLLECTION NOTICE

About this notice

The Shire of Cue collects personal information about young participants and guardians when delivering school holiday and youth activities.

Why we collect your information

The information is used to:

- register participants and obtain consent
- manage transport, excursions and attendance
- record emergency contacts and relevant safety needs

How your information may be used or disclosed

Information may be provided to authorised staff, volunteers, activity providers, transport providers or emergency services where necessary or required by law.

Is the information required by law?

No specific law generally requires you to provide this information. Providing it is voluntary, although consent and safety information may be required before a child can participate.

What happens if information is not provided?

The Shire may be unable to register the participant, provide transport or activities, contact a guardian or respond safely to an incident.

Accessing or correcting your information

You may contact the Shire's Privacy Officer to enquire about personal information held about you. Formal applications to access documents, or to amend personal information that is inaccurate, incomplete, out of date or misleading, may be made under the Freedom of Information Act 1992.
