About this notice

The Shire of Cue collects personal information when delivering activities, events and services through Shire halls and recreation facilities.

Why we collect your information

The information is used to:

- manage registrations, bookings and attendance
- process payments and activity communications
- record incidents and respond to feedback

How your information may be used or disclosed

Information may be provided to facilitators, performers, contractors, payment providers, insurers, emergency services or where authorised or required by law.

Is the information required by law?

No specific law requires you to provide this information. Providing it is voluntary.

What happens if information is not provided?

The Shire may be unable to process a registration or booking, provide the activity or safely respond to an incident.

Accessing or correcting your information

You may contact the Shire's Privacy Officer to enquire about personal information held about you. Formal applications to access documents, or to amend personal information that is inaccurate, incomplete, out of date or misleading, may be made under the Freedom of Information Act 1992.
