

CEMETERIES COLLECTION NOTICE

About this notice

The Shire of Cue collects personal information when administering the Cue-Day Dawn Cemetery and related services.

Why we collect your information

The information is used to:

- process burial and ashes applications
- administer grave and memorial reservations
- assess headstone and monumental-work applications

How your information may be used or disclosed

Information may be provided to funeral directors, monumental masons, clergy, contractors, government agencies or the public where cemetery records are lawfully accessible.

Is the information required by law?

Information required for burial, ashes, reservation and memorial applications, and for cemetery registers, is required under the Cemeteries Act 1986 and Shire of Cue Cue-Day Dawn Cemetery Local Law 2001.

What happens if information is not provided?

The Shire may be unable to process an application, reserve a site or maintain complete and accurate cemetery records.

Accessing or correcting your information

You may contact the Shire's Privacy Officer to enquire about personal information held about you. Formal applications to access documents, or to amend personal information that is inaccurate, incomplete, out of date or misleading, may be made under the Freedom of Information Act 1992.
